The Government of Rwanda has received financing from World Bank (WB) and Agence Française de Développement (AFD) toward the cost of the Energy Access and Quality Improvement Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the Contract for Design, Supply, and Installation of low voltage and medium voltage lines and service connections in Nyamasheke District.

For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursementmethod, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing, except for those payments, which the contract provides to be made through letter of credit.

- 2. The Energy Development Corporation Limited (EDCL) now invites sealed Bids from eligibleBidders for Design, Supply, and Installation of low voltage and medium voltage lines and service connections in Nyamasheke District. The tender is composed by three (3)

- Lot 2: Rangiro, Cyato, Kanjongo, Kagano and Macuba Sectors
- Lot 3: Karambi, Kirimbi, Mahembe and Gihombo Sectors
- Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" December 2019 ("Procurement Regulations") and is open to all eligible Bidders as



defined in the Procurement Regulations.

- All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of US\$ 50,000 for each lot.
